PURPOSE

- (1) This obsoletes IRM 1.36.2, Administrative Accounting and Financial Management Reports, Treasury Information Executive Repository.

MATERIAL CHANGES

- (1) This IRM is obsolete as the IRM content is contained in the following standard operating procedures, Administrative TIER Submission (IRS Submission) on the following site (S:\IFM\OFR\TIER\SOPS & Position Descriptions\SOPS). The content consists of information and guidance on IRS financial data submissions to the Treasury Information Executive Repository (TIER) system. TIER is a database containing records of all month-end Standard General Ledger (SGL) account balances at the attribute detail level for each Treasury Account Symbol. The goal of the TIER program is to ensure the integrity and accuracy of the IRS financial data. Financial Reporting is responsible for the Administrative TIER with support from Financial Management Systems.
- (2) The following responsibilities from IRM 1.36.2, Treasury Information Executive Repository, will be included in the next revision of IRM 1.1.21, Chief Financial Officer.
