- Shutdown will begin on December 03, 2025, at 12:00 a.m. Eastern time.
- Please do not attempt to access the IRIS Production environment via the Application to Application (A2A) and/or Taxpayer Portal channels during the shutdown/cutover period.
 - This includes corrections and replacements.
- Filing Season 2026 will open the beginning of January.
 - We will provide the IRIS Production environment start-up date/time later via a QuickAlerts bulletin.
 - Please monitor the IRIS Status page for any updates.

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The Information Returns Intake System (IRIS) system is a modernized system that receives information through two intake channels: IRIS Taxpayer Portal/UI and IRIS Application to Application (A2A).

You can e-file information returns for tax year 2022 and later with the Information Returns Intake System (IRIS). The system also lets you file corrections and request automatic extensions.

- No additional IRIS TCC is needed
- The "Forms and Transmission Method" will display "Form 1099 Series"
- The "Application Details" section of the application will be automatically updated to reflect the addition of the 3 forms



TY25/PY26 IRIS ATS

- The IRIS ATS environment is available for Processing Year 2026.
- Tax Year 2025 is the current year in IRIS ATS.
 - Tax Year(s) 2024, 2023 and 2022 will be accepted as prior year returns.
- If you wish to have your Software tested and reviewed for a prior year, you must use the schema for that year.



IRIS A2A ATS

IRIS Assurance Testing System (ATS) refers to the process used to test software and electronic transmissions prior to accepting forms into the IRIS A2A Production System.

- Software Developers/Issuers/Transmitters are required to test every year.
- Software Developers must pass IRIS ATS for the tax year(s) that the software package(s) will support.
- Issuers/Transmitters must pass a communication test.
- Scenarios are located at www.irs.gov/IRISATS
- IRIS ATS does not support stress or load testing.

IRIS ATS Reminders

IRIS communication test uses your Transmitter TCC.

If testing software, use your SWD TCC.

Always use your Transmitter Name and EIN from the application in the Transmitter Group.

- IRIS Schemas use “Issuer” to identify Payer/Filer and “Recipient” to identify Payee.
- Each Issuer and Recipient Taxpayer Identification Number (TIN) within the IRIS ATS Environment will use a generic digit combination created by the filer that will begin with three zeros (Ex: 000-11-1111 or 00-0111111).



IRIS ATS Reminders

Each submission must have a status of “Accepted” to pass ATS successfully.

- Software developers will create files using their own test data.
 - 1 Transmission, 5 submissions w/2 unique recipients for a total of 10 records must be included in the test file.
 - If participating in CF/SF program at least one record should include this information.
 - If supporting corrections, a second “Accepted” transmission with one submission and one record is needed.
- Transmitters will use their own test data to create a communications test.
 - Must use approved software that has passed IRIS ATS.
 - 1 Transmission, 1 submission w/2 unique recipients must be included in the test file.



IRS Automated Chatbot

- The IRS Automated Chatbot helps people quickly answer basic questions about different tax topics.
- The chatbot use either guided help through choice buttons or an open text box for a customized question.
- To launch the chatbot, simply click on the “Chat” button in the lower right corner of the webpage.
- Chatbot is available 24/7.
- Escalation to live chat is available Monday through Friday 7:30 a.m. – 7:00 p.m. E.T.
- Get answers to your questions about transmitter control codes and filing information returns electronically.

- SearchTypeCd = A for an 'Acknowledgement request'. =S for 'Status Request'
- SearchParameterType = UTID or RID...The UTID will now pull the RID for the transmitter. This will allow them to find the RIDs based on the UTIDs they create.

Maintaining your TCC Application

- Once you have completed the IRIS TCC Application process and received your TCC, it is important that you keep your account up-to-date. This includes:
 - Reviewing your TCC Application periodically.
 - Ensuring proper individuals are identified on the application.
 - Update as necessary by adding any new Responsible Officials or Contacts.
 - Updating any address changes needed - both business and mailing.

Recurring Questions

- Correction Process for forms originally filed through FIRE
 - Until FIRE retires in 2027, corrections must be filed in the same system the original form was transmitted.
 - Guidance will be provided in a future working group.
 - Stay tuned for more information as it becomes available.
- FIRE file format vs IRIS file format
 - FIRE uses American Standard Code for Information Interchange (ASCII).
 - IRIS uses eXtensible Markup Language (XML).
- Will foreign filers have the ability to apply for an IRIS TCC?
 - More information for foreign entities will be provided in a future working group.
- Will all states that accept the CF/SF, accept the IRIS schema format when the IRIS forwards the records on to the state?
 - IRS combines data for participating states in one file that includes data from FIRE and IRIS. The CF/SF program will continue to make the files available to the states in the same format that is currently provided.
 - Additional information will be provided about CF/SF program in future IRIS Working Group Sessions.

Prior Topics Currently Under Review

Topic	Update
Retirement of FIRE, AIR, etc.	IRS is targeting the retirement of the Filing Information Returns Electronically (FIRE) system at the end of December 2026. IRIS will be the only intake system available for FIRE related forms and the 1099-DA forms beginning in January 2027. We encourage you to make the transition from FIRE to IRIS. AIR retirement TBD
Update IRIS Taxpayer Portal to display Transmissions with a Transmission Type Column showing Original/Replacement/Corrections to allow filers to easily see the transmission type for each Receipt ID	No updates

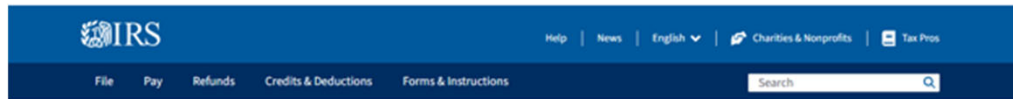

Where can I find the required fields for the CSV templates?

The CSV file formatting guidelines are provided on the Taxpayer Portal. On the dashboard click the Upload CSV with Form Data tile, then on the right side of the next page under FAQ, #8 has the template formatting guidelines. You may download the formatting guidelines for each form you need to file.

Tips for troubleshooting CSV errors are provided in Publication 5717 (Rev. 9-2024).

I uploaded a CSV file and nothing happens when I select "Start".

Confirm the file is saved as a CSV file. After uploading the file, a blue box should appear with the title "Current Uploaded File". The blue box will include the name of your file. If your file is not listed, please refresh your page and try uploading again. If your file name is in the blue box and there are no issues, the "Start" button will turn blue to indicate it is active.

The Taxpayer Portal just spins after I select "Add All" for CSV uploads.

The Taxpayer Portal notifications are not showing my download.

PDF downloads are showing in the notifications section on the Taxpayer Portal but unable to download the form.

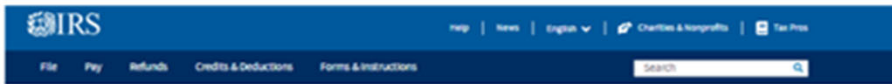

You can e-file any Form 1099 for tax year 2022 and later with the Information Returns Intake System (IRIS). The system also lets you file corrections and request automatic extensions for Forms 1099.

There are 2 ways to e-file with IRIS:

E-file through the IRIS Taxpayer Portal

This free, web-based filing system lets you:

- E-file up to 100 returns at a time
- Enter manually or by .csv upload
- Download payee copies to distribute
- Keep a record of completed, filed and distributed forms
- Save and manage issuer information

Get started

To use the IRIS Taxpayer Portal, you need an IRIS Transmitter Control Code (TCC). This 5-digit code identifies your business when you e-file forms. It can only be used for IRIS.

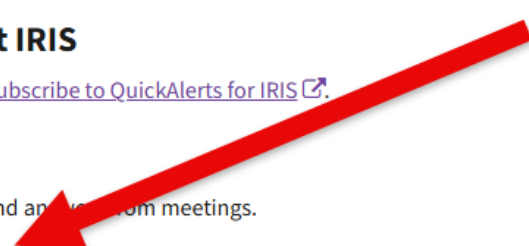

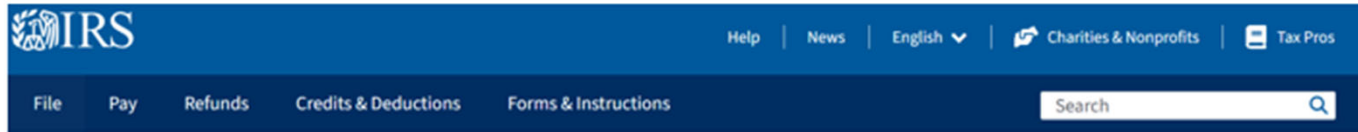
