
Publication 6961-A

Projections of the Top Five Nonpaper Information and Withholding Documents To Be Filed, CYs 2025–2033



Significant Highlights From This Update of *Publication 6961*

- Of the 40 nonpaper information and withholding documents processed for CY 2024, the top 5 accounted for 86.08% of the total nonpaper documents processed.
- The grand total number of information and withholding documents processed in CY 2024 was 4.6 billion. After CY 2024, the grand total is projected to grow at an average annual rate of 4.81%, reaching 7.07 billion documents by CY 2033.
- The grand total number of paper information and withholding documents processed in CY 2024 was 3.96 million; it is projected to decrease to 1.19 million in CY 2025, then decrease to 558 thousand documents by CY 2033.
- The grand total number of information and withholding documents processed electronically was 4.63 billion in CY 2024. It is projected to grow at an average annual rate of 4.82%, reaching 7.07 billion documents by CY 2033.
- The grand total number of paper filings for the Austin campus in CY 2024 was 1.4 million documents. The corresponding number for the Kansas City campus was 1.19 million documents. The Ogden campus processed 1.37 million paper documents in CY 2024.
