

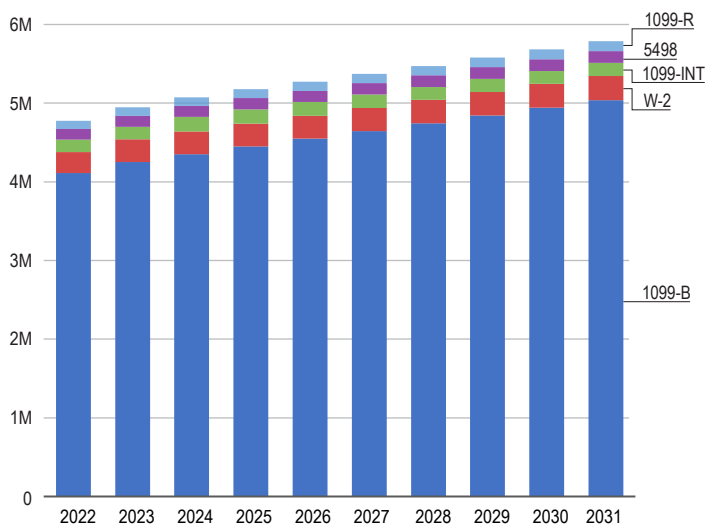

Calendar Year Projections of Information and Withholding Documents for the United States and IRS Campuses

The Internal Revenue Service (IRS) *Publication 6961* provides U.S.-level calendar year (CY) projections of information and withholding documents. This annual report also includes breakouts by filing methods. *Publication 6961-A* summarizes some of the significant highlights from *Publication 6961*.

Projections of the Top Five Nonpaper Information and Withholding Documents To Be Filed, CYs 2023–2031

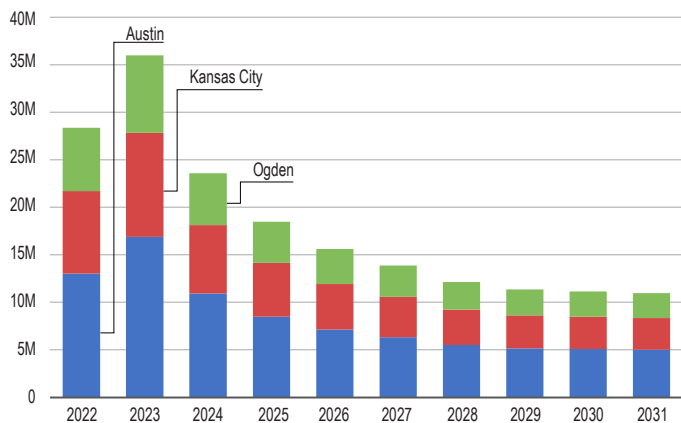

Significant Highlights From This Update of *Publication 6961*

- Of the 41 nonpaper information and withholding documents processed for CY 2022, the top 5 accounted for 88.3 percent of the total nonpaper documents processed.
- The grand total number of information and withholding documents processed in CY 2022 was 5.4 billion. After CY 2022, the grand total is projected to grow at an average annual rate of 2.25 percent, reaching 6.6 billion documents by CY 2031.
- The grand total number of paper information and withholding documents processed in CY 2022 was 28.3 million; it is projected to increase to 36 million in CY 2023, then decrease to 10.9 million documents by CY 2031.
- The grand total number of information and withholding documents processed electronically was 5.4 billion in CY 2022. It is projected to grow at an average annual rate of 2.2 percent, reaching 6.6 billion documents by CY 2031.
- The grand total number of paper filings for the Austin campus in CY 2022 was 13 million documents. The corresponding number for the Kansas City campus was 8.6 million documents. The Ogden campus processed 6.6 million paper documents in CY 2022.
